We need you! We have all kinds of historic preservation and maintenance tasks including some in the cool of the AC! The schedule is flexible during the summer.

If you have an RV you can move right in! MKR participates in the Florida Park Service Resident Volunteer Program. Resident Volunteers are required to do 20 hours of service in exchange for a lovely secluded campsite. We are right on Orange Lake in a beautiful rural setting. The real bonus to



this is that we don't have the trash and bathroom duty of the popular beach parks, while providing beautiful scenery, a location close to both beaches and springs and a really lovely atmosphere. We have 2 full service hook-up sites (50 amp); though your motorhome will need its own bathroom/shower. We also have a laundry facility.
